


Meet the Executive Committee - Vice Chairman













CHAPTER NEWS









June 7, 2015 - First Organizational Meeting

On June 7, 2015, we held the first organization meeting at the Princeton Public Library, New Jersey. The meeting opened with a welcome from the chairman, Kah-Wai Lin, PPSA, followed by an introduction to the PSA Chapter by vice chairman, Guo Jiang Ou, EPSA. Then Kah-Wai gave an overview of the Chapter organization. We then made the final decision to name our Chapter as PSA Metropolitan Chapter (PSA-MET), and voted for the logo, and discussed the general organization of the Chapter, (i.e. the executive committee, financial planning, Chapter activities, publicity, membership, risk management program, and the roles of Chapter working committees — website committee, exhibition committee, program committee, social media committee and newsletter committee). Next, Mohammad Ali Salim, MPSA led the discussion about articles of association. Kah-Wai then announced the activities plan for 2015-2016. Finally, the petition letter was signed by the Chapter executive committee.

June 7, 2015 – Official Approval of PSA Metropolitan Chapter

On June 16, 2015, just about a month after the idea was initiated and just a week after our organizational meeting, Kah-Wai Lin, PPSA received an email from Nan Carder, EPSA – "Good News.... The motion for the new PSA Metropolitan Chapter to become a PSA Chapter has been approved". PSA Metropolitan Chapter was now official!

Awards and acceptances earned in the national contest will counted toward the PSA-MET national contest credit systems for national exhibition distinction titles. For more information, see next page.

Distinction Titles for PSA-MET National Photographic Exhibition







- 1. PSA-MET distinction titles for National Photographic Exhibition are earned through the accumulation of credit via the quarterly contest and national contest.
- 2. Quarterly contests are organized 4 times per year, and it is open to all PSA-MET members. Credit will be given as followed:
 - Gold 5 points
 - Silver 4 points
 - Bronze 3 points
 - HM 2 points
 - Acceptance 1 point
- 3. National Contest is organized once per year, and it is open to US resident only. Credit will be given as followed:
 - Gold 10 points
 - Silver 8 points
 - Bronze 6 point
 - HM 4 points
 - Acceptance 2 points
- 4. The following title will be awarded:
 - Associate, Metropolitan National Photographic Exhibition (A.MAPE)
 A.MAPE will be conferred when 50 points or more are earned. A certificate will be awarded.
 - Senior Associate, Metropolitan National Photographic Exhibition (SA.MAPE)
 SA.MAPE will be conferred when 100 points or more are earned. A certificate will be awarded.
 - <u>Fellow, Metropolitan National Photographic Exhibition (F.MAPE)</u>
 F.MAPE will be conferred when 200 points or more are earned. A certificate and a bronze lapel pin will be awarded.
 - Senior Fellow, Metropolitan National Photographic Exhibition (SF.MAPE)
 SF.MAPE will be conferred when 500 points or more are earned. A certificate and a silver lapel pin will be awarded.
 - <u>Master, Metropolitan National Photographic Exhibition (M.MAPE)</u>
 M.MAPE will be conferred when 1000 points or more are earned. A certificate and a gold lapel pin will be awarded. M.MAPE holder will have the life-time fee waive for PSA-MET national contest.
- 5. The rules are subjected to change upon approval of the PSA Metropolitan Chapter's executive committee.

MEMBER SHOWCASE – Xinxin Liang, EPSA









